




Preview Lunch at the Hilton

60th Reunion arrangements are firm for the Bayfront Hilton in downtown St. Pete, May 2 – 4, 2014. A block of rooms has been set aside for classmates who choose to stay there. Rooms are \$119 per night plus 12% tax. Also, parking is \$10 per day, with graduated rates for parking less than a day.

Friday, May 2 will be a social gathering for celebrants to visit and get caught up. There will be a door prize for a lucky classmate. Time for visiting is the focus, so Friday will not have planned entertainment. The theme of *Starlight and Sawdust – Reprise* will be carried out in the food for the evening. Cost for Friday is \$25

Saturday evening will be a little more formal, with a banquet and tentative entertainment by the SPHS choral group, *The Pitchforks*. Recall that they were a great hit at our previous reunion. Also, there will be a DJ for dancing. Saturday cost is \$45, if you want the prime rib or Salmon entree.

During the weekend, there will be plenty of time to see the transformed and nearby downtown attractions such as the Fine Arts Museum, St. Pete Historical Museum, Dali Museum and the Dale Chihuly Glass Museum.

In order to make arrangements for the hospitality room and for meals, we request that you send in a **registration** with payment for any meals you plan to eat. Even if you are only coming to visit and not eat, we need to have an idea of who is coming. The registration form is included on the following page.
